



Life Way Christian School Part-Time Enrollment

Life Way Christian School supports the Christ-centered education that many home school parents provide for their children. In efforts to partner with Christian parents, we are offering them the option of part-time enrollment at LWCS. We understand that as children grow up and the classes become more advanced and elective options increase, parents may look outside the home for support in these areas. Therefore, Life Way Christian School would like to partner with these families and allow home school students to take upper level courses and electives at LWCS. The following are the requirements for part-time enrollment:

General Information:

1. This program is only for home school students and not for students enrolled in other full-time school programs.
2. Only 7th-12th grade students are eligible for part time enrollment.
3. Students will be required to adhere to all dress code and attendance policies.
4. Students are eligible for the LWCS Learning Enrichment Center if space is available.
5. Part-time students cannot participate in the Warrior Athletic Program.
6. Admission will be granted only if students meet requirements and space is available.
7. Students will receive a transcript from LWCS for all courses they successfully complete.

Admissions:

1. Fill out the Life Way Student application on line or call the school office. On the application, communicate that you are a home school student seeking part-time enrollment.
2. LWCS is committed to entering into a partnership with the Christian home and therefore at least one parent must give evidence of a Christian testimony.
3. Students must give evidence of a Christian testimony.
4. Students must meet all academic and behavioral standards.
5. All needed paperwork must be on file in the school office and fees paid before enrollment is complete.
